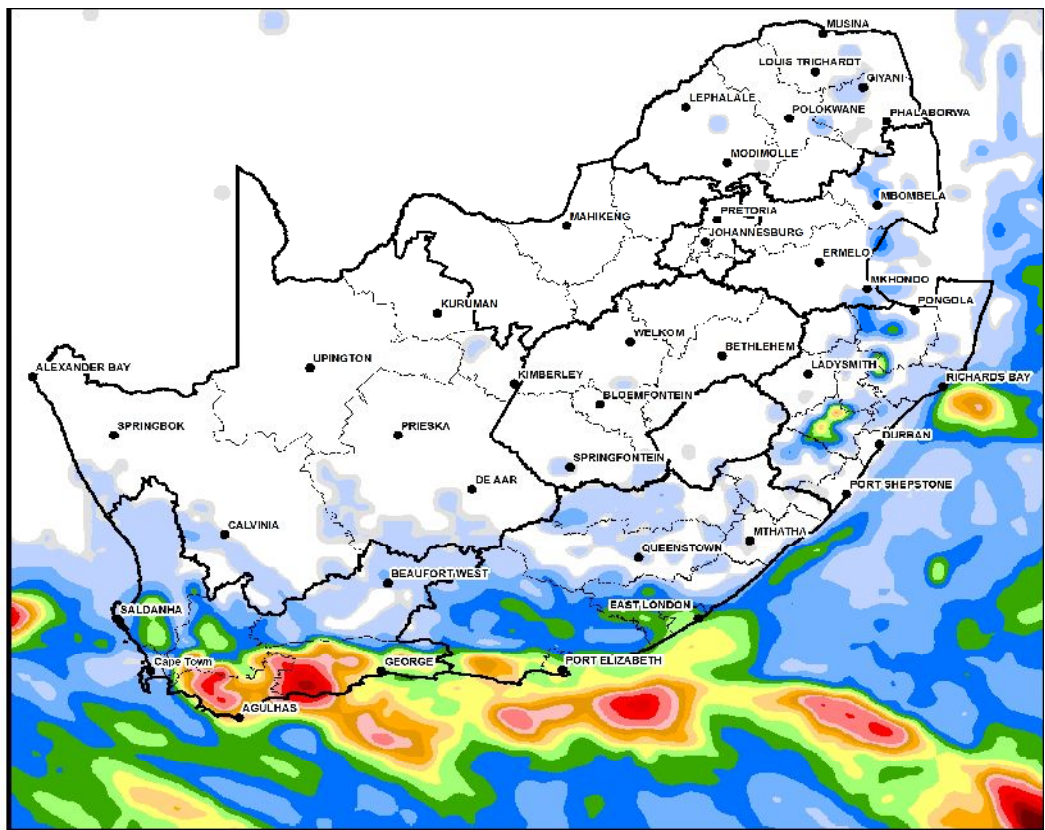
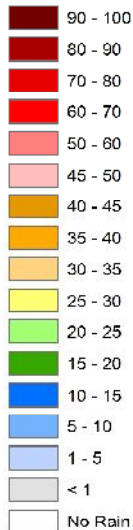

Average Minimum Temperatures: 2-8 May 2018

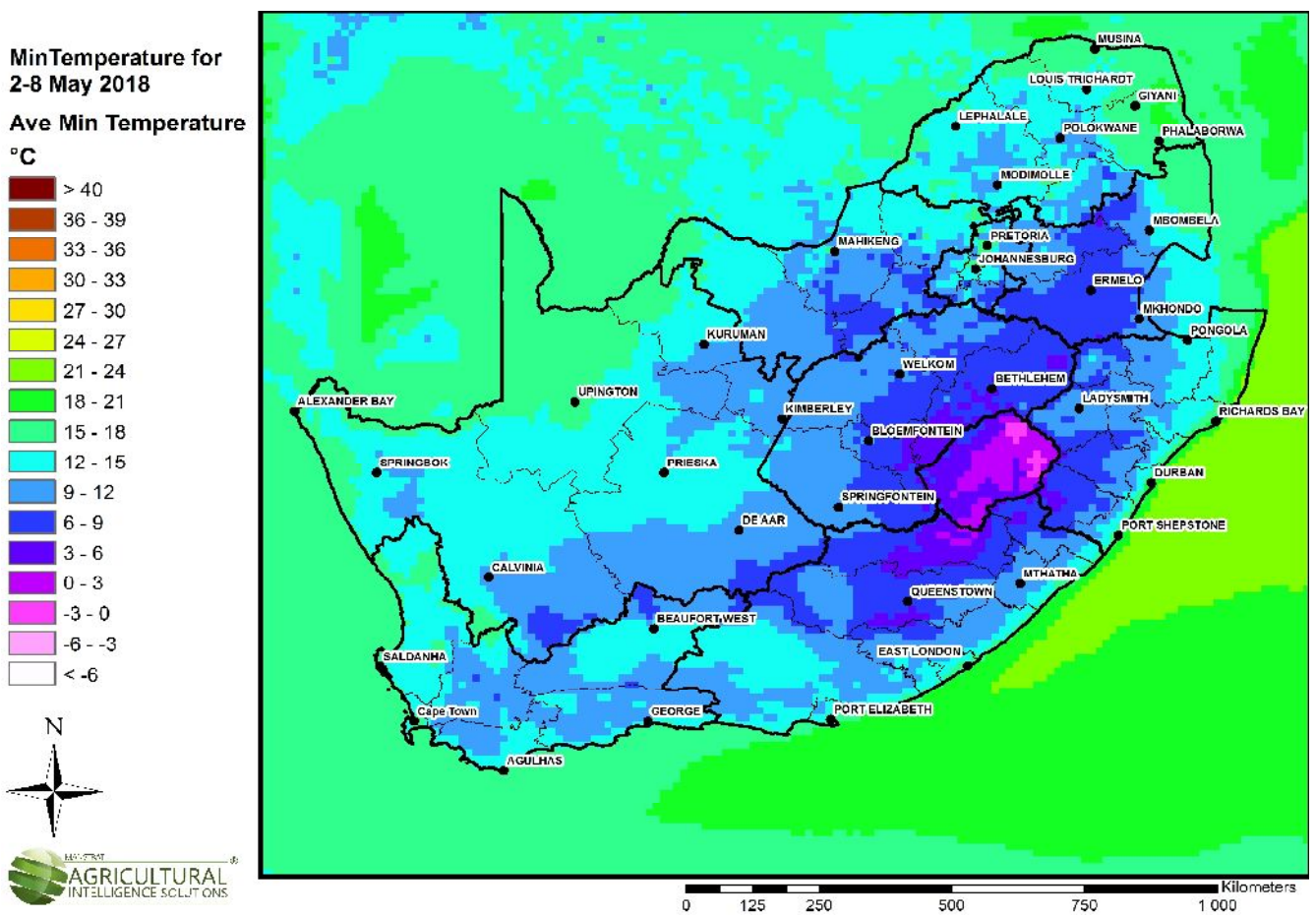


Figure 2: Average Minimum Temperatures 2-8 May 2018.

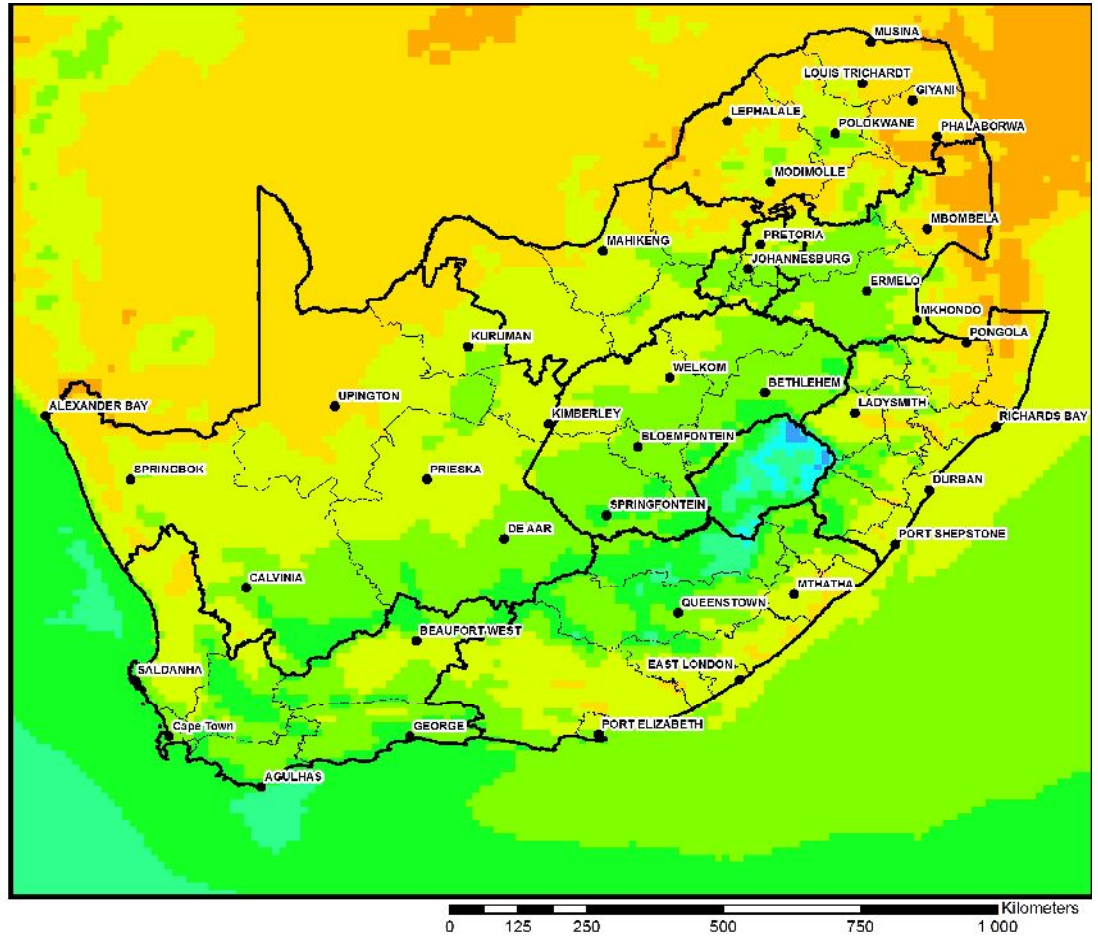


Figure 3: Average Maximum Temperatures 2-8 May 2018.
