15-21 May 2018





Figure 1: Expected precipitation 15 to 21 May 2018.

Rainfall is expected for the north eastern parts of the country, and will be accompanied by snow over the Drakensberg, at the start of week. Heavy rainfall is expected over northern KwaZulu-Natal, and the South African Weather Service has issued flood warnings for the area. Around the weekend, a new weather system will move in over the western parts of the country bringing rain to the Northern and Western Cape provinces.





Average Minimum Temperatures: 15 to 21 May 2018




Figure 2: Average Minimum Temperatures 15 to 21 May 2018.

Snow on the Drakensberg mountains will cause the minimum temperatures to drop to below 10 C for most parts of South Africa. Minimum temperatures are expected to rise for most parts around the weekend.




Figure 3: Average Maximum Temperatures 15 to 21 May 2018.

Maximum temperatures will be decidedly lower this week due to the snow on the Drakensberg and the expected widespread rainfall. Maximum temperatures will increase to above 20°C around the weekend.
