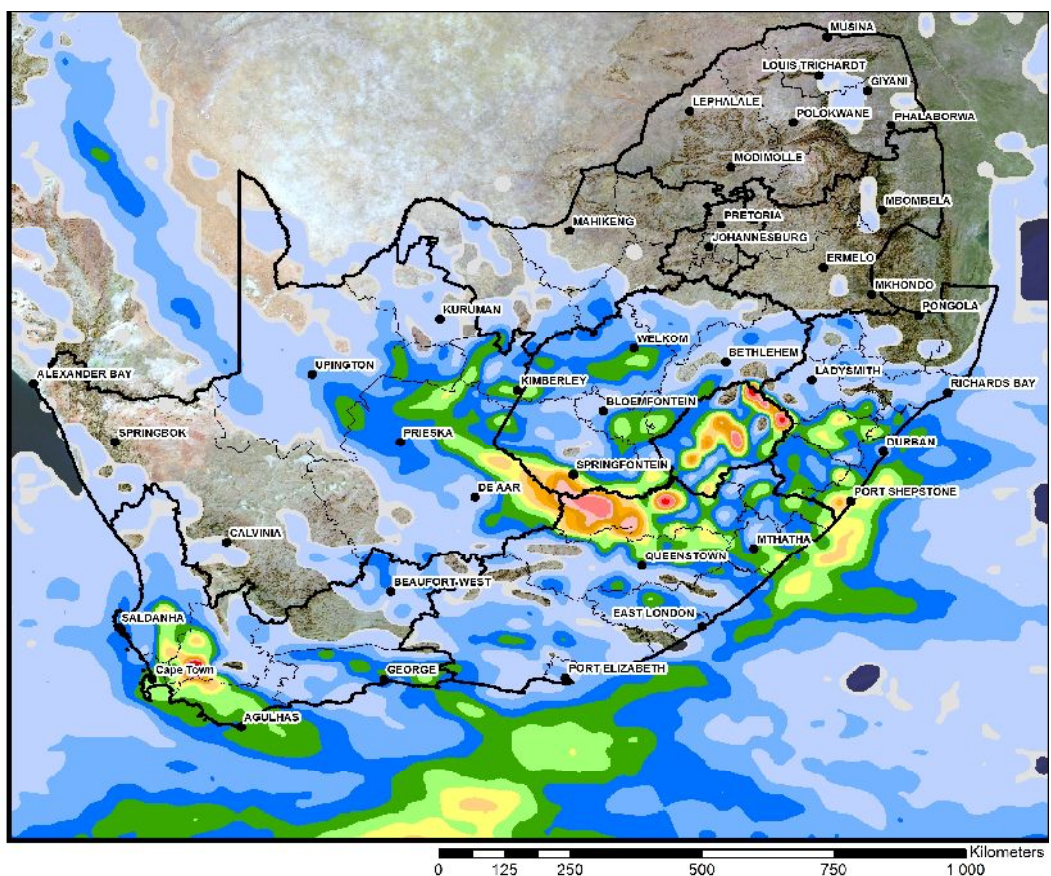
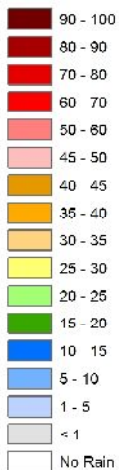


Figure 1: Expected precipitation: 18 to 24 September 2018.

Our weekly rainfall starts off over the Western Cape with an expected 30 mm over some areas and then spreading eastward towards the Eastern Cape and KwaZulu-Natal. Showers are also expected over the eastern parts of the Northern Cape and most of the Free State over the coming weekend.





Average Minimum Temperatures: 18 to 24 September 2018

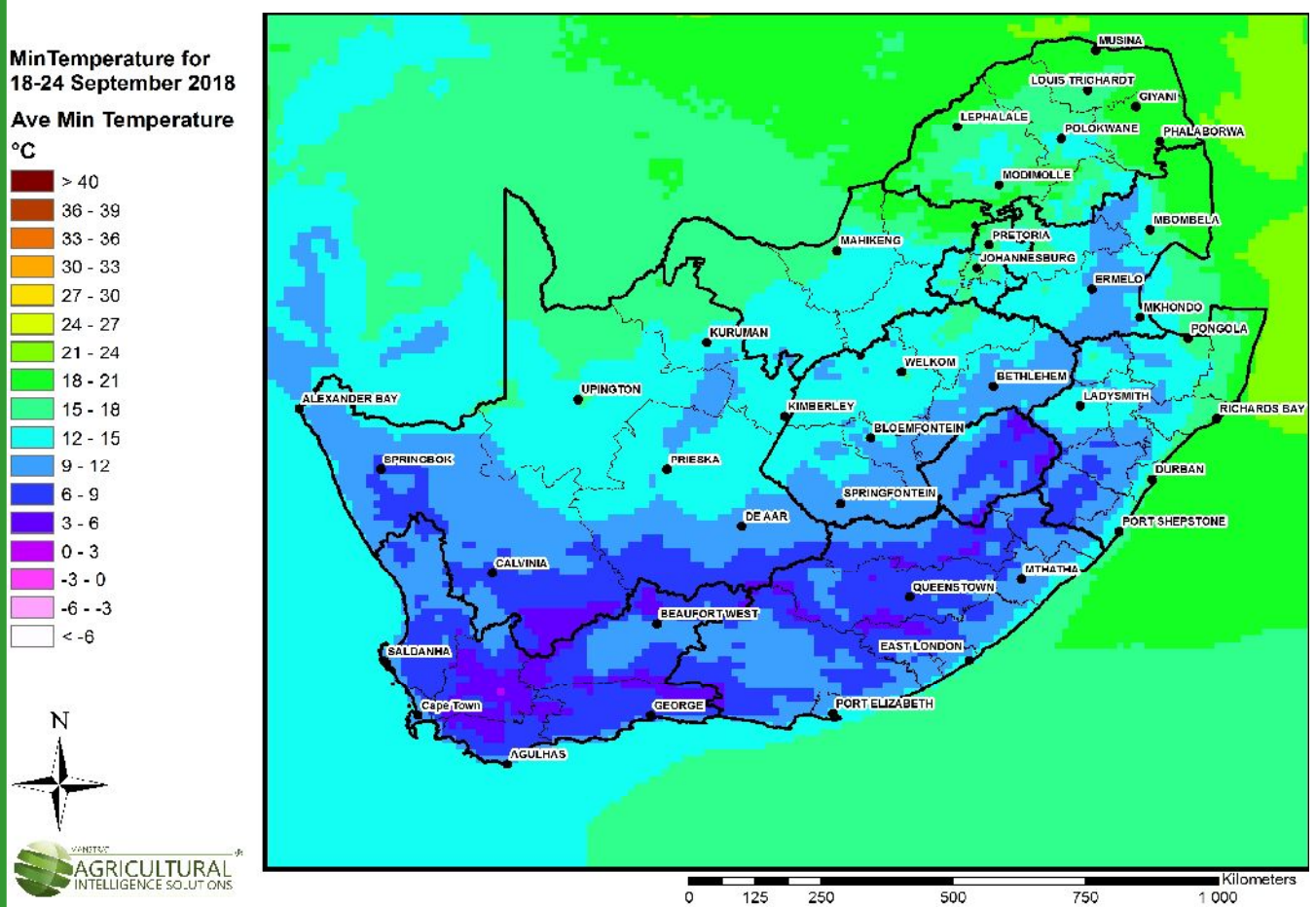


Figure 2: Average Minimum Temperatures: 18 to 24 September 2018.

Mild minimum temperatures – higher than 12°C - are expected over most parts of South Africa while the escarpment, the Western and Eastern Cape areas will continue to experience colder - below 10°C - minimum temperatures.

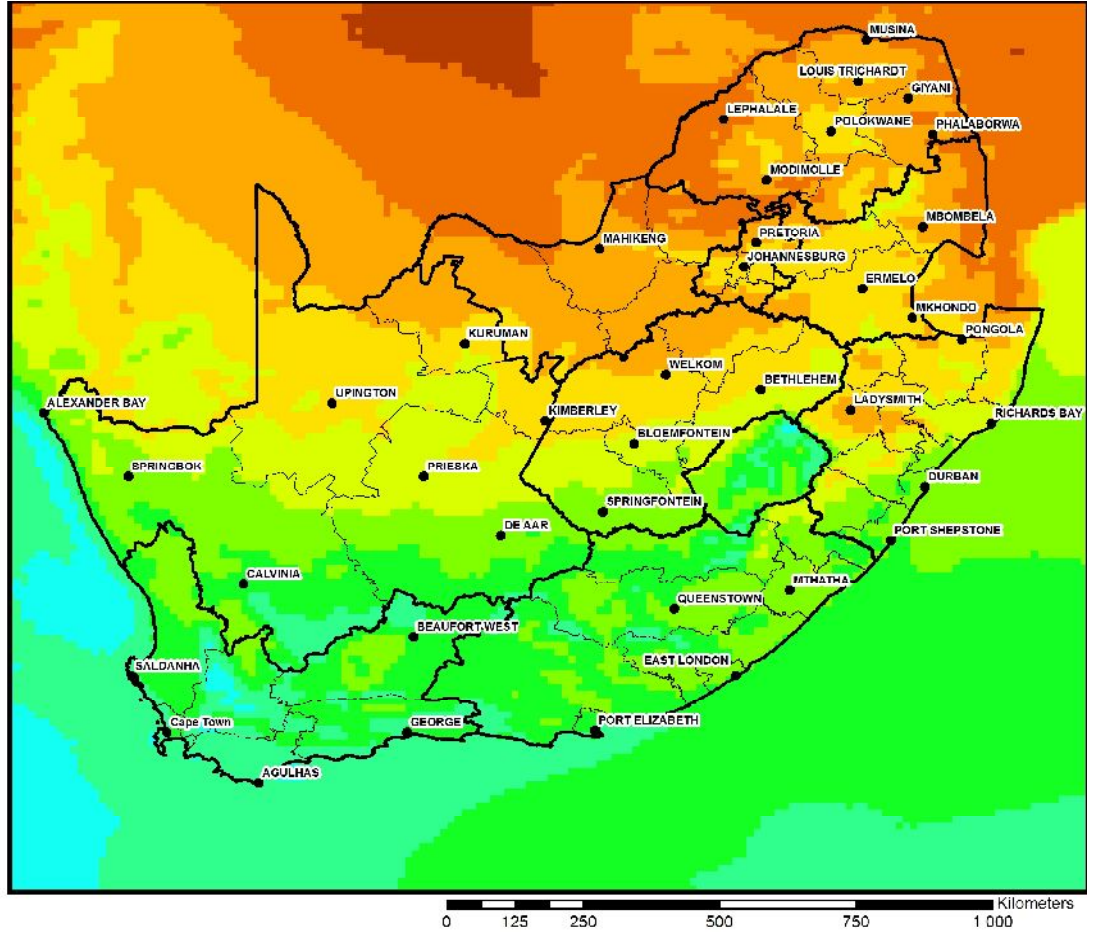


Figure 3: Average Maximum Temperatures: 18 to 24 September 2018.

This week starts off with heat wave conditions over the northern regions of South Africa with maximum temperatures expected to reach 35°C over Gauteng on Wednesday. There will be some relief over the weekend as the maximum temperatures are expected to drop somewhat. Mild maximum temperatures are expected over the southern regions of the country.
